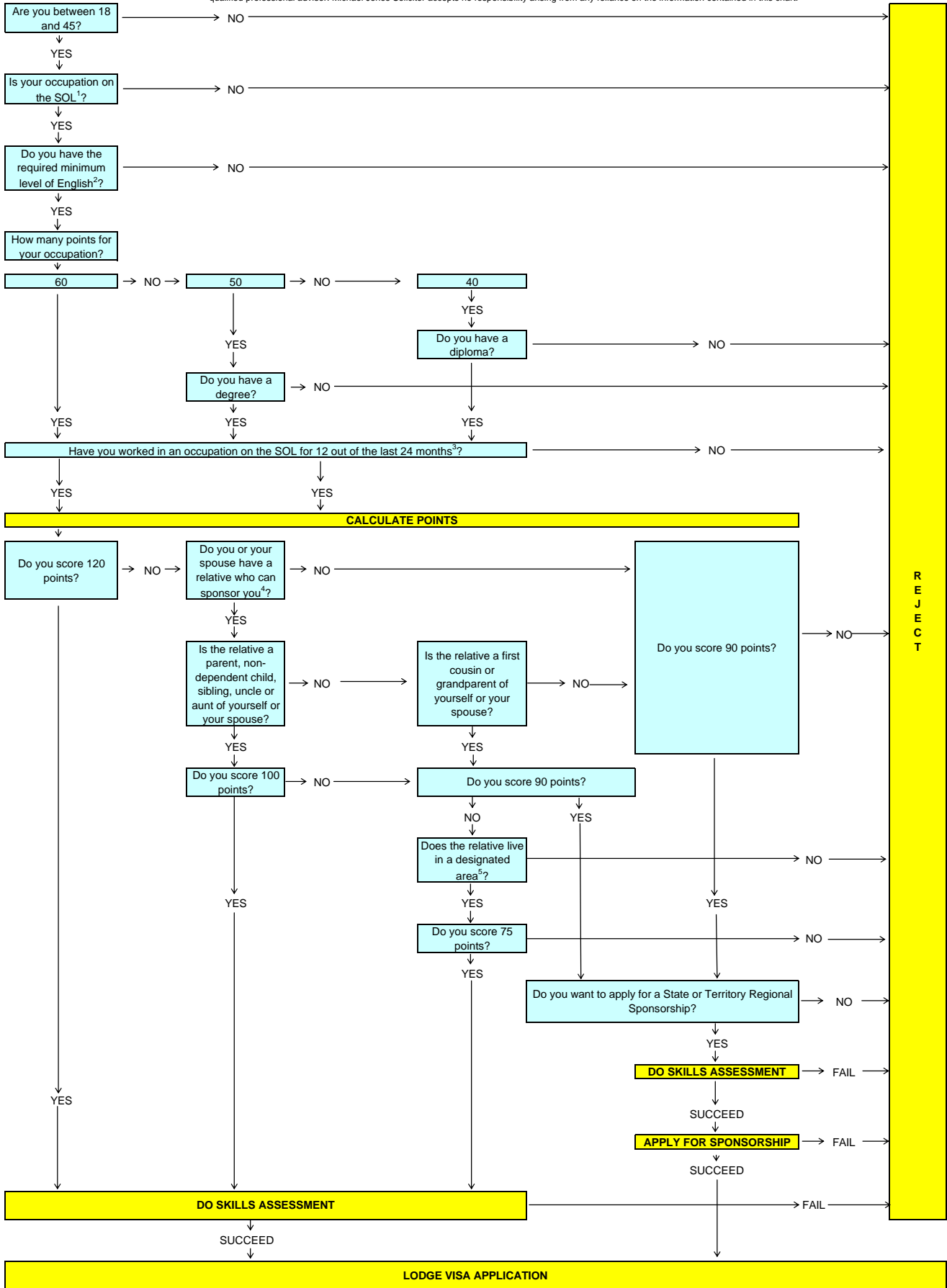


# SKILLED MIGRATION TO AUSTRALIA - ASSESSMENT CHART

<sup>2</sup> Occupations in Major Group IV of the Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO) require "vocational English", while all others require "competent English". These terms are defined in the migration legislation.

<sup>3</sup> This requirement may be waived for some recent graduates of Australian education institutions

<sup>4</sup> Your sponsor must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident, living in Australia.

<sup>5</sup> "Designated areas" are mainly outside the Sydney-Wollongong-Newcastle strip, metropolitan Brisbane or metropolitan Perth. Applicants depending on designated area sponsorship will only be granted provisional visas and must settle in the area and find work before being eligible to apply for permanent residence.
